

## **Pine Mountain Volunteer Firefighter Requirements**

### **I. To Become Certified as a Firefighter**

- A. You have eighteen (18) months to complete these requirements.
- B. Successfully complete Chapter 1: Introduction to Firefighting.
  - 1. In-house class.
  - 2. Introduction to protection.
  - 3. Receive key to stations.
- C. Successfully complete Chapter 6: Firefighter Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
  - 1. In-house class.
  - 2. Personal protective equipment.
  - 3. Receive personal protective equipment:
    - a. Boots, pants, coat, helmet, and gloves.
- D. Successfully complete wildland firefighting.
  - 1. Outside class.
  - 2. Receive wildland PPE:
    - a. Jumpsuit, helmet, and gloves.
- E. Successfully complete NIMS 100, 700, 200, and 800.
  - 1. Take the course online through the FEMA website.
  - 2. Emergency Management and Homeland Security.
  - 3. Receive pager / radio.

### **II. To Maintain Certification**

- A. Attend at least 50% of fire meetings.
- B. Attend at least 50% of fire trainings and work sessions.
- C. Complete 16-hours of qualified training each year.

### **III. Learn to Operate and Use PMVFD Equipment**

- A. Trucks and pumps.
- B. All equipment on trucks.

### **IV. Know and Communicate Your Capabilities**

Know what you can and cannot do, communicate that to others, and do your best.
